**NOTICE OF  
REINSTATEMENT PROCEDURES**

The Financial Institutions Commission (“FIC”) implemented the Online Corporate Registry on January 20, 2025, accessible at [www.palauregistries.pw](http://www.palauregistries.pw). The one-year re-registration transition period concluded on January 20, 2026.

Palau corporations that failed to re-register by the transition deadline have been administratively dissolved. Foreign corporations that failed to re-register have had their certificates of registration revoked.

A Palau corporation that has been administratively dissolved may apply for reinstatement within two (2) years from the effective date of dissolution, subject to a reinstatement fee of \$250 for for-profit corporations and \$150 for non-profit corporations.

A foreign corporation whose certificate of registration has been revoked may apply for reinstatement within one (1) year from the effective date of revocation, subject to a reinstatement fee of \$500 for both for-profit and non-profit corporations.
